Frequently Asked Questions

What is the LIFT campaign?

LIFT stands for 'Living Into our Future Together'. Together, we have a vision of growth and vibrancy that will take us into 2020. The LIFT campaign is our financial appeal to fund a 3/4-time Associate Minister for at least a 3-year time period to help us become a stronger, more viable church. This individual will focus on outreach to help grow the congregation, lead our Children Youth and Family Ministry and develop a Young Adult Ministry. This campaign will also provide money for outreach and worship ministry expenses.

What is the financial goal of the campaign?

Our goal is to raise pledges totaling \$125,000 that will help fund this new position.

Is a pledge to this campaign in addition to my commitment to the annual budget?

Yes, the **LIFT** campaign pledge is separate and in addition to your annual giving pledge to the church.

You will find that the enclosed pledge card asks you to make two commitments, one for the general fund and one for the **LIFT** Campaign.

What are the dates for this campaign?

The **LIFT** campaign is being held in conjunction with the **Fall Annual Stewardship Campaign**. We are asking members to make a 3-year pledge to the **LIFT** Campaign that will begin January 1, 2018 and conclude on December 31, 2020. There will be a special presentation regarding the **LIFT** campaign on Sunday, November 5th, from 10:00 a.m. until 10:45 am. Please join us. We are asking everyone to <u>return their</u> commitment card on Sunday, November 12th.

Who is in charge of this campaign?

At the congregational annual meeting in January, members voted to move forward with a financial appeal for funds needed to support our plan for a 3/4-time Associate Minister over a 3-year time period. We have a dedicated funding campaign team in place to oversee this process as directed by the Church Board and congregation.

How much should I consider giving?

Each individual or family will make their own decision about their financial commitment. We encourage you to use prayer, conversation, these materials, and deep reflection to guide you. We offer these following suggestions:

LIFT Campaign:

Consider pledging at least half of what you gave to the 2014 Mission Appeal (facility improvements). If you have not pledged to a special campaign like this, we suggest a commitment that is equal to one-half of one year's general fund giving, and paying that over three years.

Annual Stewardship Drive:

We encourage you to consider making a 5% increase over what you gave to this fund last year to help cover annual cost increases in our general budget. We are pleased to share that three key leadership teams at the church have all committed to this level of giving.

How can I pay my pledge to the LIFT Campaign?

You may pay your pledge as a one-time gift, or over the specified 3-year time period. Your gift may be included in your offering envelopes, via electronic fund transfer, or by bringing it to the church office.

What if my financial situation changes before the end of the 3-Year Pledge period?

You may change your commitment pledge at any time by contacting the church office.

Ways to Give

You may choose to honor your pledge to the LIFT Campaign with weekly, monthly, or yearly payments. You may also choose to make a one-time gift. Here are some ideas about giving that you may not have considered.

Priority Budgeting:

Choose to rearrange some priorities to give a greater gift to this campaign. This may lead to postponing a planned purchase, or maybe eating out one less time per month.

Unexpected Cash:

Maybe you have recently sold an item you no longer use or are a benefactor of an inheritance.

Increases in Income:

If you have incremental salary increases, overtime pay, or bonuses consider including this as a part of your gift.

Special Giving:

Consider donating items of value, gifting stock, or using cash value from insurance policies.

The Ministry of an Associate Minister Adding a 3/4-time Associate Minister will help to

support our vision for Living into 2020. This vision of growth, engagement, and connection will require all of us to participate. The primary areas for this person will be:

Outreach Ministry and Engagement

Provide vision and leadership for this area. Assist with congregation membership growth and expanding partnerships in the community.

Children, Youth, Young Adults, and Family Ministries

Provide development and leadership for current programs, as well as new endeavors for Young Adults.

Worship

Provide regular worship leadership through planning, preaching, and presiding at worship.

Commitment Guide

Our Redeemer Lutheran Church is comprised of givers of various amounts. We celebrate every single gift and giver. A pledge of ANY amount is an important and valued part of this campaign - Every gift matters!

Prior to making your commitment, please read over the materials, pray, and meditate on God's Word:

Dear Our Redeemer Congregation,

The seasons are changing! That's what our calendar says. "The times, they are a-changin" is what Bob Dylan sings. And in the Biblical book of Ecclesiastes we read, "There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under heaven".

Whether it be from weather, music or Scripture, the world around us continues to change. We know this to be true in the church, too. Today, there are changes in the way people view the church, even seek out the church and certainly participate in the life and work of the church.

This is a difficult time to be the church, yet the reasons for being the church are still just as strong! We have a great God who desires relationship; Jesus' touch on our lives brings grace and calling and the Spirit is alive and stirring in hearts. Now, we are coming to you as the congregation with our other main priority. That is to grow the congregation and develop our ministry with children, youth, young adults and families. We had a very successful pastoral intern program for nine years and during that time had a variety of youth staff. Members now wish to see a permanent minister on staff who can provide more continuity over many years and help us in new ways. It is to this end that we now come to you with an invitation to join us as we begin our new LIFT campaign, which will be a three-year campaign to lead us into a stronger future in terms of our membership and ministry.

LIFT stands for Living Into Our Future Together. Together, we want to focus on our growth in membership, our gathering in worship, and our going into the world. We have the year 2020 in our sites as a short-term goal line for becoming better as a congregation. Part of living into this future together will include reflecting on how we engage in the church and find calling in the world. But part of this living into our future together includes an invitation of financial generosity on each of our parts.

We invite you to read through these LIFT Campaign materials and to attend a session between worship services on Sunday, November 5th to learn more about this special fund drive. Please take some time to prayerfully read and engage in conversations around the LIFT Campaign materials and consider how God can use you and your gifts (financial and personal) to help Our Redeemer live into a stronger future.

We will develop 20 new leaders for ministry teams and other roles

Missions

We will increase our Missions distribution by 20% and involve 20 new people in mission projects

Connections

We will cultivate having 20 faith conversations per person We will increase the people participating in small group studies by 20%

Children, Youth, Young Adult and Family Ministry
We will increase our Sunday School participants to at least 20 students per week
We will engage 20 families/individuals with regular interactions and connections

Giving

We will increase our General Fund giving by 20%

We will add at least 20 new households as members
